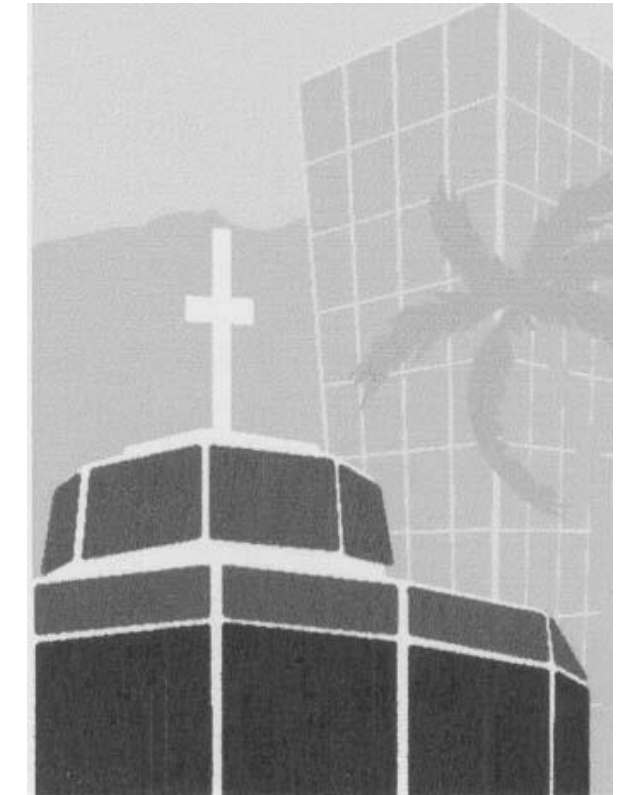


CAROLING AND CITY LIGHTS
