There are correct ways to interpret the Bible and there are incorrect ways.

You can you do a good Bible study.

The secret of a great Bible study is learning to ask the right questions.

All questions in every good Bible study fall into one of four categories ... observation, interpretation, correlation, and application.

I. Observation: What does it say?

You write down what you observe. The difference between Bible reading and Bible study is you use a pencil.

II. Interpretation: What does it mean?

The Bible means what it means.

In communication, we often use words that don't literally mean what they say.

In the Bible you can often know what a passage means by looking at the context around it.

Words often have many different meanings. What a word means is based on the context.

III. Correlation: What other verses explain it?

The best commentary on the Bible is the Bible.

Use what's clear to explain what's unclear.

IV. Application: What am I going to **do** about it?

"How does it apply to me today?"
