A summer-time tradition for our Church family returns. After a busy week it's time to TGIF!



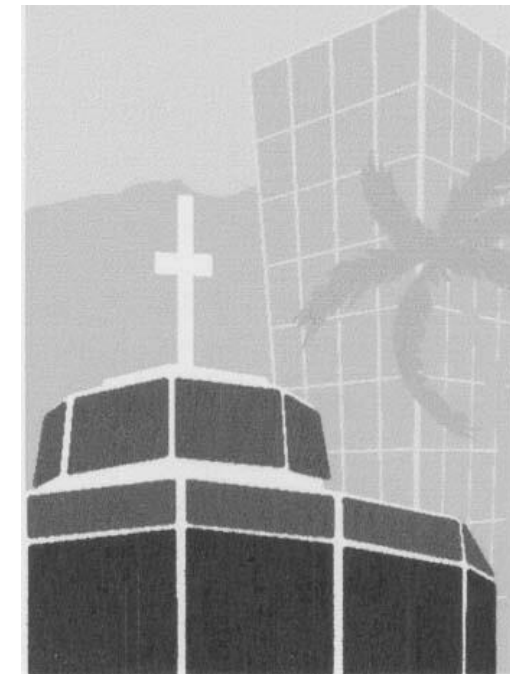

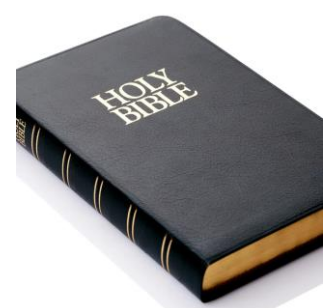
