3. A GODLY MAN IS COOPERATIVE.


Each of the terms, brother, fellow worker and soldier are relational and descriptive of the Christian life.

We are a family. The phrase brother and sister is used about 133 times in the Bible to refer to Christians.

We are a fellowship; fellow workers. We have the same task, mission.

We are an Army; soldiers fighting the same enemy.

We need each other. You have strengths that I need, I have strengths that you need.

4. A GODLY MAN IS CONSIDERATE.

"For he [Epaphroditus] longs for all of you and is distressed because you heard he was ill." (26)

Delivering the offering to Paul Epaphroditus nearly dies. When word gets back to the home church, they all were concerned and worried. What is E's reaction? He is distressed by their distress.

Considerate means you are concerned about how other people feel.

It can be rude to just blurt out whatever comes to your mind without thinking about how it might affect others.

There's a time to say things and a time to not say things; a mature, considerate persons knows the difference.

"Husbands be considerate as you live with your wives." 1 Peter 3:7,

The number one cause of marriage problems is selfishness

Men and women are different, because of that, they each have to work at being considerate.
