The earth is the LORD 's, and everything in it. The world and all its people belong to him" - Psalm 24:1

Satan has succeeded in convincing many that God is a **<u>party pooper</u>**.

God's ultimate motive in establishing the boundaries, standards and principles for our lives is not for His benefit but for ours.

Stewardship = the proper <u>management</u> of the resources God <u>entrusts</u> <u>into our care.</u> (Matthew 25:14-30)

When the God who gave and who is so lavishly generous to us takes up residence in our lives we can't help but be **givers**.

The big obstacle to stewardship in our lives as believers is that we are sometimes confused about **who owns our stuff**. Gen.1:1; Psalm 24:1

We are **<u>accountable</u>** to God for how we manage <u>**His**</u> resources. Romans 14: 10-12

Giving of our financial resources is **only part** of our stewardship.

Stewardship involves the giving of yourself. And that includes...

## **STEWARDSHIP OF <u>TIME</u>** (Ephesians 5:15-17)

According to a Harris poll the average American watches television  $\frac{17}{10}$  hours a week. Other research shows that elementary school children watch TV, on the average of  $\frac{20}{20}$  hours a week. By the time the average child is 15 years old he/she will have witnessed the violent destruction of more than  $\frac{13,000}{13,000}$  human lives.

## STEWARDSHIP OF WORDS (Matthew 12:36; James 1:26; 5:5-10)

"He who has a sharp tongue will soon cut his own throat"

Stewardship is more of a **privilege** than a responsibility, because when you give, ultimately you are the **benefactor**.

What God really wants is <u>you</u>.
