- 1. BUILD ON IT.
- 2. FEED ON IT.
- 3. LIVE BY IT.
- 4. GROW THROUGH IT.

In the parable of the soils...

- a. Hardened soil. Represents a closed mind. Action Step: **cultivate an open mind.**
- b. Shallow soil. Represents a superficial mind. Action step: Make time for God's Word.
- c. Soil with weeds. Represents a preoccupied mind.

God gives truth that is planted in my mind, it starts growing, but then I get distracted and let other things choke it out of my life.

Action step? **Eliminate the distractions** in my life.

If you're burning the candle at both ends you're not as bright as you think you are.

d. The good soil. Represents a willing mind.

The seed in good soil grows deep roots, and then it bares much fruit.

Action step is to **cooperate** with God.

Obedience = Doing what I'm told to do, When I'm told to do it, with a right-heart attitude.

## 5. ACT ON IT.

"Do not merely listen to the word and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says." James 1:22

If I'm not living it, I'm living a life of self-deception.

You only believe the parts of the Bible you actually do.

## 6. TRUST IN IT.

God will never guide you in the wrong direction.
