- I. Our God is a God of <u>Peace</u>. (II Cor. 13:11; I Cor. 14:33)
 - Therefore, God <u>wills it</u>!
 - You can't <u>blame</u> God for war. <u>Sin</u> is responsible. (Ja.4:1&2)
- II. We are to be <u>Peacemakers</u>. (Matthew 5:9; James 3:17 & 18)
 - Righteousness is "<u>Right living with God and each</u> other".
 - Peace begins <u>in our hearts</u>.
 - God does not <u>call us</u> to do that which does not also
 <u>equip us</u> to do.

 - <u>Knowledge</u> of the enemy (Ephesians 6:11 & 12)
 - The Belt of <u>Truth</u> (Ephesians 6:14a)

 - The Shield of <u>Faith</u> (Ephesians 6:16)
