40 Days for Life A special meeting at One Love, Kaka'ako on Wednesday, March 1 will acquaint you with 40 Days for Life, a praying ministry outside abortion clinics. The meeting at One Love will feature Mayra Rodriguez, who quit after 17 years as Planned Parenthood director in Glendale, AZ. A local couple will tell how God caused them to choose life for their unborn baby instead of abortion and the consequences of their decision.

A daily prayer vigil (7 a.m.-7 p.m.) outside the Beretania Street Planned Parenthood has already begun. Last fall, babies were saved and at least one clinic worker left after talking to prayers and others have quit. Prayer works!
