March for Life this Friday, Jan. 19 at the State Capitol from 3-6 p.m. This commemorates the 1973 Supreme Court decision legalizing abortion on demand. Since the overturning of the federal ruling, several states have legalized abortion for all 9 months. Stand with your fellow citizens to show that innocent human life is a precious gift, from conception to natural death. Our state legislators will be considering bills to expand abortion to 9 months and also weaken the regulations regarding euthanasia. If you can't come early, be sure to come by 5 p.m. to march around the capitol building.

Pray for Kidnapped Israelis Please remember the remaining more-than-100 Israelis kidnapped by Hamas in the October 7 invasion of Israel. They remain in Hamas' hands somewhere in Gaza. Of special concern is Kfir Bibas, a year-old baby, who was taken along with his parents and four-year-old brother, Ariel. Also pray for the mental and physical health of the kidnapped women because former women captives have confirmed that they were physically and sexually abused. (The chant, From the river to the sea, means the erasure of Israel from the Jordan River to the Mediterranean Sea.)
