Five basic truths about spiritual warfare:

1 THERE'S AN INVISIBLE WORLD THAT'S JUST AS REAL AS THE VISIBLE WORLD.

2 WE ARE INVOLVED IN AN INVISIBLE WAR, THAT HAS ETERNAL IMPLICATIONS.

3 OUR FOE IS FORMIDABLE, AND HIS GOAL IS TO DESTROY US.

"Be sober. Your adversary, the devil, prowls about like a roaring lion seeking someone to devour." 1 Peter 5:8.

When lions prowl, they're looking for something that's vulnerable and easy to kill.

Lions don't prowl all the time, neither does Satan. It's when you're vulnerable, and discouraged that Satan is on the prowl.

The double whammy is the temptation and then the guilt & condemnation.

"But Michael the archangel when he disputed with the devil and was arguing about the body of Moses, he didn't dare pronounce against him a railing judgment but said, 'The Lord rebuke you!'" Jude 9

Take authority over Satan and his associates in the name of Jesus. "Satan, in the name of Jesus, in the authority of His shed blood and the power of His resurrection, I demand that you leave me alone."

We never need to be afraid of our enemy but there needs to be a healthy respect for Satan and demonic forces recognizing that they are not intimidated by us, but they have to submit to the authority of Christ.

One of Satan's biggest lies is that God is a cosmic vending machine.

Satan leads you to believe happiness is God's primary goal for you.

Life is not a playground. It's a battleground.

God's goal for your life as a believer is not happiness, its holiness.

From Genesis to Revelation, Satan and demons play a major role.

25-30% of Jesus' interactions, parables and miracles involved demons.

Jesus takes this subject seriously, and I think it's about time we do too.
