

Three things that the resurrection accomplished...

THE RESURRECTION **VINDICATED** JESUS.

Evidence for the resurrection ...

- 1. The staying power of the story.
- 2. Changed lives.
- 3. Fulfilled prophecy.
- 4. Eyewitness accounts.

THE DISCIPLES BELIEVED SO STRONGLY,
NEARLY EVERY DISCIPLE DIED
A MARTYR'S DEATH.

James was beheaded. Simon Peter was crucified upside-down.

THE RESURRECTION DEFEATED DEATH.

THE RESURRECTION RESTORES HOPE.
