King Nebuchadnezzar is a case study in what it's like to think of yourself as God.

Idolatry is when you let something take God's place in your life.

The foundation of every idol is the same...me, myself and I.

Daniel is drafted to serve King Neb.

A growing characteristic of people in our culture is self-centeredness.

Nebuchadnezzar was not only important and powerful he was evil. That's why we are surprised to learn... Nebuchadnezzar wrote Daniel chapter 4.

"To the nations and peoples of every language... It is my pleasure to tell you about the miraculous signs and wonders that the Most High God has performed for me. How great are his signs, how mighty his wonders!"

What caused this transformation? God visits him in a terrifying dream.

Daniel interprets the dream. God's message to Neb..."you are about to get cut down to size", but he blows it off.

Questions to help us to see, if we are like Nebuchadnezzar...

#1. What's my motivation?

#2 Who do we identify as the source of my strength/success?

#3 What's the purpose of my life?

Happiness as a goal/purpose is elusive.

The more we acquire the more we desire.

Daniel courageously tells the king, "*Renounce your sins*..." But he doesn't and everything Daniel said would happen happened.

He lives like a wolf-man for years, but finally comes to his senses.

His motivation changes from living for himself to living for God.

What are you going to have to go through before you realize you should let God be in the driver's seat of your life?

"...every knee will bow... and every tongue will confess that Jesus is Lord." Philippians 2:10&11
