Stewardship is a **lifestyle**.

Stewardship is not just about giving money it's also about giving our **time and talent**.

Stewardship is really nothing less than **"all that we do with all that we have"**.

500 verses on prayer. 500 verses on faith. **2,000** verses on money and possessions.

Of Jesus' thirty-eight parables, almost **half** talk about how to handle money and possessions.

In the Gospels an amazing **one out of ten** verses deals directly with the subject of money.

It is natural for people to **value something**.

The issue is what is your **motivation**.

Earthly treasure is a bad **investment**.

The most serious thief we face is **death**.

"It is no fool who gives up what he cannot keep in order to gain what he cannot lose." - Jim Elliot

What you value will be what you are **committed to**.

You can be **poor** and just as likely to struggle between God and Mammon.

The amount in Jesus' sermon is **100%**

Stewardship is not just about how much of what I **own** will I give to God. It's about how much of **me** will I give to God.
