Earthly treasure is a bad investment.

The most serious thief we face is death.

Stewardship is a lifestyle.

Stewardship is not just about giving money it's also about giving our time and talent.

What you value will be what you are committed to.

Stewardship is really nothing less than "all that we do with all that we have".

You can be poor and just as likely to struggle between God and Mammon.

500 verses on prayer. 500 verses on faith. 2,000 verses on money and possessions.

The amount in Jesus' sermon is 100%

Of Jesus' thirty-eight parables, almost half talk about how to handle money and possessions.

Stewardship is not just about how much of what I own will I give to God. It's about how much of me will I give to God.

In the Gospels an amazing one out of ten verses deals directly with the subject of money.
