For every time the First Coming of Christ is mentioned in the Bible, the Second Coming is mentioned 8 times. The Lord Himself refers to His return 21 times.

The prophets foretold it: Zechariah 14:4

The Angels announced it: Acts 1:11

Jesus confirmed it: Matthew 24:27, 29-30

John the Apostle foretold it: Revelation 1:7

The last words of the New Testament focused on it: Revelation 22:20

The Description of Christ – Revelation 19:12-13; 1:14; 2:18 The eyes of the Lord affirm His omniscience. The crown points to His sovereignty. His robe dipped in blood reminds us that He is the Lamb of God.

**The Armies of Christ** – Revelation 19:14; Jude 14, 15; II Thessalonians 1:7-10 When Christ comes the second time, it will be primarily a time of judgment.

The army will be made up of saints and angels. The army will not fight. All of the fighting will be done by the Commander-in-Chief,

**The Authority of Christ** – Revelation 19:15-16; Revelation 1:16; Isaiah 9:6 When the Lord returns the second time, He will strike the nations with the sharp sword of His mouth.

## The Application of Christ's Second Coming

1. Refrain from Judging Others Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord comes, who will both bring to light the hidden things of darkness and reveal the counsels of the hearts. Then each one's praise will come from God. I Corinthians 4:5

2. Remember the Lord's Table *For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death till he comes.* I Corinthians 11:26

3. Relate to One Another in Love And may the Lord make you increase and abound in love to one another and to all, just as we do to you, so that He may establish your hearts blameless in holiness before our God and Father at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ with all His saints. I Thessalonians 3:12-13

4. Recommit Ourselves to Ministry I charge you therefore before God and the Lord Jesus Christ, who will judge the living and the dead at His appearing and His kingdom: Preach the word! Be ready in season and out of season. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching. II Timothy 4:1-2

5. Remain Steadfast You also be patient. Establish your hearts, for the coming of the Lord is at hand. James 5:8

6. Reach the Lost for Christ But you, beloved, building yourselves up on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit, keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life. And on some have compassion, making a distinction; but others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire... Jude 20-23
