**3/29 A Visit from The Thief on the Cross.** Luke 23:32&33; 39-43. To one of the criminals hanging next to Jesus on the cross Jesus said, "Today you will be with me in paradise." What if that thief were to visit us today? What would he say? How did he view things from his perspective? And what might he think about how we treat Jesus today?

**4/5 Signs of Jesus' Soon Return: The King is Coming.** Revelation 19: 11-21. As we look at the instability in our world, today we can't help but ask, "Are we living in the end-times?" In this series of periodic sermons Pastor Barry has been unraveling some of the mystery surrounding end-time events as he has examined what the Bible has to say about life in the last days.
