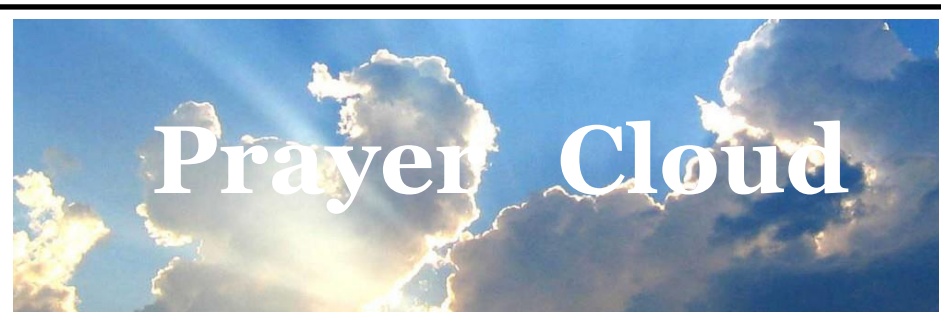

Our Facebook page can be an outreach tool, but we need your help... the more you "like" and "share" our posts the greater our outreach and impact will be! When you share posts with your

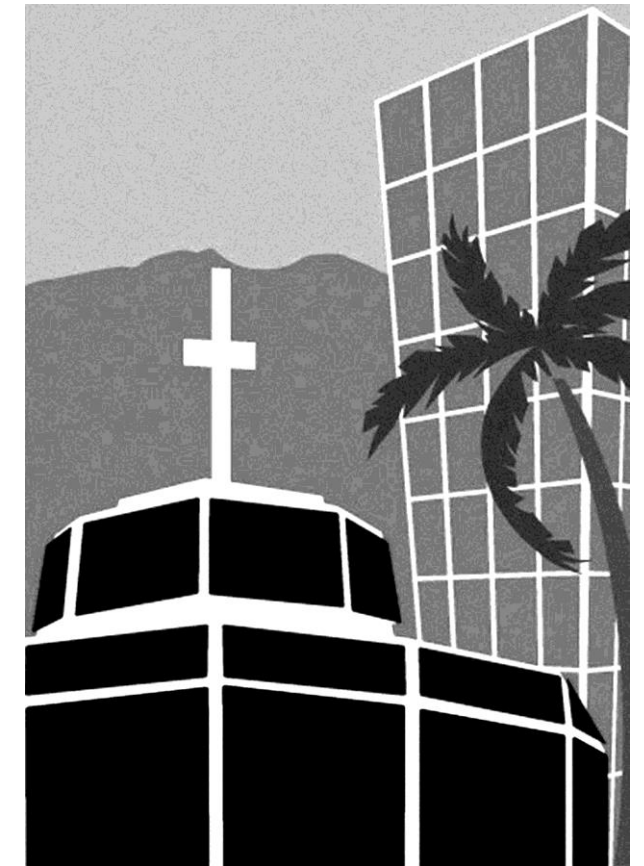

UP-COMING SERMONS

4/19 *Finding Hidden Treasure.* Matthew 13:44-46. In Jesus' day buried treasures were regularly found. Under threat of invasion, you hid your treasure. The people listening to Jesus' parable about discovering treasure would have been able to relate well to such stories. Jesus gives two ways we're on a treasure hunt. Some of us are surprised finders of God's rule in our lives. Others are serious seekers. We're looking for something more meaningful in life, and we find something even better than what we were seeking: the reign of God in our lives through a relationship with Jesus. The Good News of the Gospel is that at any moment you can be surprised by hidden treasure in Christ.

4/26 *Standing in the Loser's Circle.* Psalm 51:4-10. Winning isn't all it's cracked up to be. There are some benefits and rich blessings that come to people who experience loss now and then. In this sermon Pastor Barry will share the benefits & blessing that can experience when we are standing in the Loser's Circle.

5/3 *Pleasing God with Our Worship.* Isaiah 1:11-15. We often evaluate worship based on how we feel about it, but how does God feel about it? In Isaiah 1:11ff we learn about a kind of worship that God detests. In contrast to that we see an example of worship God desires in Isaiah 6:1-8. In this sermon Pastor Barry shares the six characteristics of worship found there.
