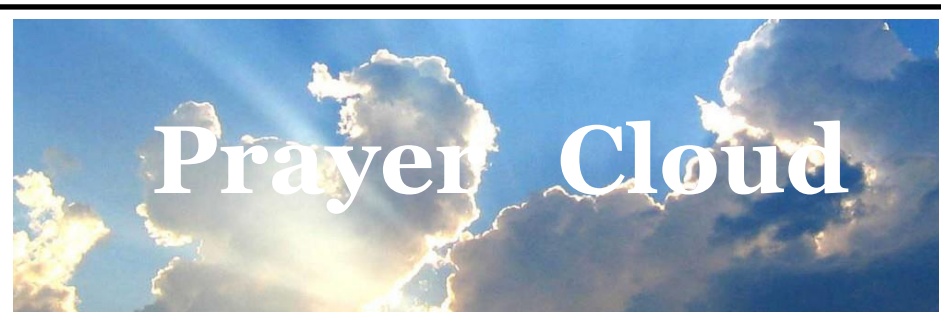

**UP-COMING SERMONS**

**5/3 Pleasing God with Our Worship.** Isaiah 1:11-15. We often evaluate worship based on how we feel about it, but how does God feel about it? In Isaiah 1:11ff we learn about a kind of worship that God detests. In contrast to that we see an example of worship God desires in Isaiah 6:1-8. In this sermon Pastor Barry shares the six characteristics of worship found there.

**5/10 A Few Good Men and Women.** Judges 2:12-16. For 300 hundred years, during a period of Israel's history known as the Judges, a pattern of disobedience, oppression, repentance, and deliverance repeats itself a dozen times. A dozen judges, eleven of them men; one of them a woman, would lead the nation of Israel back into obedience to the Lord but then they'd fall away again. That would lead to oppression, followed by repentance, forgiveness and deliverance. In this sermon Pastor Barry focuses on the one woman judge, Deborah, whom the Bible describes as "a woman of influence."
